

WCBA Bee Removal WhatsApp Group

Standards and guidelines

A Bee removal is the successful transfer of a bee colony from its natural nesting area into a manmade (managed) beehive and the safe relocation to an apiary site afterwards.

Members agree to comply with the following:

- Be a paid-up member of WCBA
- Abide by the WCBA Code of Conduct
- Have a valid DALRRD registration number and certificate
- Provide full details (contact person, contact telephone number, address, town, suburb and location of the colony) when posting/requesting for a removal
- Please note that uploading media like images or videos of other people, private property or personal information without their permission is unlawful and strictly prohibited and the poster is responsible for obtaining this permission
- The first beekeeper taking on the task, will report accordingly on the group
- Always keep to the topic of beekeeping
- Stay within the boundaries of common social and civilized acceptability
- No unacceptable foul language
- No character assassination or defamation of another individual or organisation
- No unacceptable and unjustifiable racism, political and religious topics
- The Admins do not accept responsibility for any comments or posts that are in contravention of the Laws of the Republic of South Africa and such posts and comments will be deleted immediately after an Admin is made aware of it
